This DVD includes two additional bonus features: an impassioned scripture reading from 1 John by Dr. Barbara Isaacs and a poignant anecdote by Bishop Roy Sano, who recounts his witness, as a young boy, of redemptive actions by a Methodist pastor and some Methodist women as Sano and his family were departing to an internment camp for Japanese Americans during World War II.
